Subject: Resolution of Support Delta/Northwest Representation Election

Proposed Resolution:

WHEREAS a merger has brought these two flight attendant groups together to form the world's largest airline, and

WHEREAS this merger provides the combined group with the opportunity to negotiate an industry leading World Class Contract, and

WHEREAS AFA-CWA is a family of over 55,000 flight attendants enjoying the benefits of representation by and for flight attendants, and

WHEREAS AFA Constitution and Bylaws includes as one of its primary goals to unite all cabin crew members into our union,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that on this historic date when our Delta colleagues finally have the opportunity to cast their vote for AFA-CWA representation, the EXBOD comprised of Alaska, American Eagle, America West, Air Wisconsin, ASA, AirTran, Compass, Frontier, Hawaiian, Horizon, Lynx, Miami Air, Mesa, Mesaba, Northwest, Piedmont, PSA, Ryan International, Spirit, United, USA3000 and US Airways pledge our full support and look forward to welcoming the newly combined Delta flight attendant group into our AFA-CWA family.
