

DELTA AIRLINES EMPLOYEES RIGHT TO FORM A UNION
Action Item

WHEREAS, the free choice to join with others to bargain for better wages and benefits is essential to economic opportunity and living standards; and

WHEREAS, airport and airline employees have the legal right to join together for the purpose of collective bargaining; and

WHEREAS, this right to join together for the purposes of collective bargaining must, by law, be without interference, influence or coercion from management; and

WHEREAS, we cannot, with moral conscious wage war for democracy in foreign lands, while denying such democracy to Delta Airlines employees who are on the front lines of passenger safety right here at home; and

WHEREAS the Delta flight attendants have just filed a petition with the National Labor Relations Board calling for an election within 30 days; and

WHEREAS the National Labor Relations Board has granted the request of the Delta Airlines flight attendants.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the NAACP support the freedom of Delta Airlines employees to join a union free from employer intimidation, harassment and/or coercion; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the NAACP supports the rights under Federal law of workers at Delta Airlines to exercise their rights to form a union should the majority of them choose to do so.
